1. Authorize staff to pursue the ARC grant for \$2 million dollars, requiring a 50-50 match, towards the construction of a water tank and booster pump, with the match coming from the restricted water fund.
2. Adopt an amendment to the FY2026 Operating Budget to reflect the receipt of grant funds revenue and expenditures, the Trinka Davis Grant and the GRPA Boost Grant.
3. Select DCW Construction to do renovations to the Senior Center, as specified in the proposal dated 4/27/26, in the amount of \$33,864.00.
