



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City of Temple Distilled Spirits, Malted Beverage and Wine by the Drink Ordinance

ORDINANCE 2010-7

An ordinance for the licensing, control, taxation, and regulation of the sale of, distilled spirits, malt beverages and wine for beverage purposes by the drink for consumption only on the premises where sold in Temple, Georgia

Section 19: Expiration: Renewal of License

- A) All licenses granted under this ordinance shall expire on December 31st of each year. Licensees who desire to renew the licenses shall file applications, with the requisite fee enumerated in Section 13, with the City Council on the forms provided for renewal of licenses for the ensuing year. Any renewal applications received after November 30 shall pay in addition to the annual fee a late charge of 20%. If licenses application is received after January 1, such application shall be treated as an initial application, and the applicant shall be required to comply with all rules and regulations for granting of licenses as if no previous licenses had been held. If a licenses application is received after January 1, investigative and administrative cost will be assessed.
- B) All licenses granted under this ordinance shall be for the calendar year, and the full license fee must be paid for a license application filed prior to July 1st of the license year. One-half of a license fee shall be paid for a license application filed after July 1st of the license year, except for applications for a temporary special event license which shall not be halved.
- C) Any person renewing any license issued under this ordinance who shall pay the required fee, or any portion thereof, after January 1st, shall, in addition to the annual fee and late charges, pay simple interest on the delinquent balance at the annual rate then charged by the Internal Revenue Service of the United States on unpaid federal income taxes.

Section 32-55: Evidence of qualification required if applicable

- A) Any business required to obtain health permits, bonds certificates of qualification, certificates of competency, criminal background check or any other regulatory matter mandated by state or federal law or local ordinance shall first, before issuance of a city business registration, show evidence of such qualification.

- B) Any business required to submit an annual application for continuance of that business shall do so before the registration is issued.

Section 45: Hours and Days of Sale

- A) Distilled spirits, beer and/or wine shall not be sold distributed for consumption on the premises except between the hours of Monday through Friday of 10:00 a.m. through 1:00 a.m.; and Saturday 10:00 a.m. through 12 midnight.

- B) No distilled spirits, beer and/or wine shall be sold for consumption at any time in violation of any local ordinance or regulation or of any special order of the governing authority.

- C) **SUNDAY SALES**-The sale and distribution of distilled spirits, beer and/or wine shall be allowed between the hours of 12:30p.m. and 11:30 p.m.
