**Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 6:30PM by Mayor Michael Johnson  
Council Members Present: Bivins, Bracknell, Miller, Walden, Wallace

**Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance**

The Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Michael Johnson

**Approve the published agenda of this date's City Council Meeting, as presented:**

There was a motion to approve the published agenda as presented by Council Member Bracknell, second by Council Member Bivins. Vote 5-0.

There was a motion to approve by Council Member Walden, second by Council Member Bracknell, Vote 5-0.

There was a motion to approve by Council Member Walden, second by Council Member Bracknell, Vote 5-0.

**New Business:**

1. Conduct a public hearing on the application for a license for the retail package sale of beer and wine at the convenience store located at 895 Bar J Road. Application by Jay Mata Di Business, LLC, doing business as Villa Rosa Food Mart.

Mayor Johnson asked if there was anyone present to wanted to offer public comment on the application for a license for the retail package sale of beer and wine at the convenience store located at 895 Bar J Road. There was no one present that wanted to make comment. Mayor Johnson closed the public hearing.

2. Consider approving the application of Jay Mata Di Business, LLC, doing business as Villa Rosa Food Mart, for a license for the retail package sale of beer and wine at the convenience store located at 895 Bar J Road. Licensee and owner Roshniben Patel.

There was a motion by Council Member Wallace to approve the application of Jay Mata Di Business, LLC for a license for the retail package sale of beer and wine at the convenience store located at 895 Bar J Road, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 5-0.

3. Authorize the Mayor to sign the necessary documents on behalf of the City of Temple to bind commercial insurance coverage for the policy period of May 30, 2019, to May 30, 2020, with the carriers Selective Insurance and KeyRisk.

Mayor Michael Johnson explained that Preston Hagler from J. Smith Lanier was present at the last meeting to explain the policy and answer any questions. City Administrator Bill Osborne stated that Mr. Hagler had provided the council two additional pages which included the new police vehicles; there was only a very small increase in cost. There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to authorize Mayor Johnson to sign the necessary documents to bind commercial insurance coverage for the period May 30, 2019-May 30, 2020 with the carriers Selective Insurance and Key Risk, second by Council Member Bivins. Vote 5-0.

4. Approve a new 12-month software maintenance and support agreement with Casselle, Inc.

There was a motion by Council Member Bivins to approve the 12 month software maintenance and support agreement with Caselle, Inc., second by Council Member Bracknell. Vote 5-0. Council Member Bivins also mentioned that on site training for Caselle is \$1,500 a day. She said that she would like the Council to consider this and she will be bringing it up at an upcoming Committees Meeting.

5. Adopt a City of Temple Animal Control Ordinance, which is similar to the Carroll County Animal Control Ordinance in accordance with the intergovernmental agreement between these two local governments for animal control services.

City Attorney Mike McCrae explained that this ordinance is the same as the ordinance Carroll County uses. It is before the Council for adoption. There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to adopt the animal control ordinance, second by Council Member Bivins. Vote 5-0.

6. Authorize the City Attorney's Office to initiate action to clarify the City of Temple's ownership of the unpaved section of Rocking D Road south of Villa Rosa Road, which has been used as a public street for a number of years.

City Administrator Bill Osborne explained that the Council has discussed Rocking D Road on several occasions. A couple of property owners on this road have concerns and they would welcome the City to get involved into resolving the land ownership. Council Member Bracknell stated that based on the conversation at the last committee he would make a motion to to authorize the City Attorney's Office to clarify the City of Temple's ownership of the unpaved section of Rocking D Road, second by Council Member Bivins. Vote 5-0.

7. Appoint one of the City of Temple's elected officials to be this local government's voting delegate at the Georgia Municipal Association's 2019 annual meeting late in June.

There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to appoint Mayor Johnson to be the City's voting delegate at the 2019 GMA annual meeting, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 5-0.

8. Make the decision to support or oppose the four elected municipal officials nominated to serve as the Georgia Municipal Association District 4 officers for 2019-20, with the nominated new District President being City of Griffin Commission Chairman Doug Hollberg.

There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to support the four elected officials nominated to serve as the GMA District 4 Officers for 2019-2020, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 5-0.

**Executive Session, if needed**

Mayor Johnson explained that there is going to be an Executive Session but, there will be no vote afterwards. They will be discussing the Public Works Director position that Tommy Freeman declined to take. There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to go into Executive Session, second by Council Member Bivins. Vote 5-0. Executive Session began at 6:47PM.

At 7:36PM the elected officials came out of Executive Session. There was a motion from Council Member Bracknell to come out of Executive Session, second by Council Member Walden, vote 5-0.

**Closing Comments:**

Mayor Johnson- wanted to report that his daughter and son-in-law and granddaughter are now residents of Temple.
