1. Special recognition of the individuals who delivered meals from the Temple Senior Center to a number of homebound senior citizens at mid-day Monday through Friday each week earlier in the year following the initial impact of the COVID – 19 pandemic.

2. Adopt a resolution to recognize and honor each of the individuals who provided special services to some senior citizens in the Temple area by delivering meals to them from the Temple Senior Center on Monday through Friday each week during the COVID – 19 crisis earlier in the year.

6. Waive the fees for the Verve Church to use the City of Temple Recreation Department parking lot on Saturday, September 12, for a free community food giveaway service event.
7. Waive the fees for Twice Baked Psyche Century to use the City of Temple Recreation Department pavilion and gymnasium restrooms on Sunday, July 19, for a charity cycle event
8. Approve a Temple Recreation Fundraiser that will include a car show and cook-off on Saturday, August 8, in accordance with plans presented to the City Council during the June 29 Recreation Committee meeting
9. Report on plans to recognize and honor the members of the Temple Police Department with a special Appreciation Day

Report on the notification received by the City of Temple from Waste Pro USA, in accordance with the current agreement, of a 2.9 percent increase in all charges for residential and commercial solid waste collection and disposal services effective July 1, 2020, due to an adjustment made in the United States Department of Labor's Consumer Price Index (CPI).
